GARDEN OF
REMEMBRANCE

- 1: The allotment of plots is restricted to parishioners of the Church of St. Colman.
(A parishioner is one who subscribes to the Freewill Offering through the envelope system/direct debit/or other recorded offering).
- 2: Those who wish to put cut flowers of the site; a standard vase must be purchased. This must be placed on the site, not on the surrounding stone area.
(The standard vase is black granite 8"x8"x6" - this is the only one permitted).
- 3: The plaque will consist only of the name and date of death of the deceased. This will be supplied by the Select Vestry.
- 4: No artificial wreaths or artificial flowers will be permitted.
- 5: To assist in the general tidiness and appearance of the site, all dead flowers and wreaths must be removed from the plot and church grounds.
- 6: These regulations may be reviewed at any time by the Rector, churchwardens and Select Vestry.
